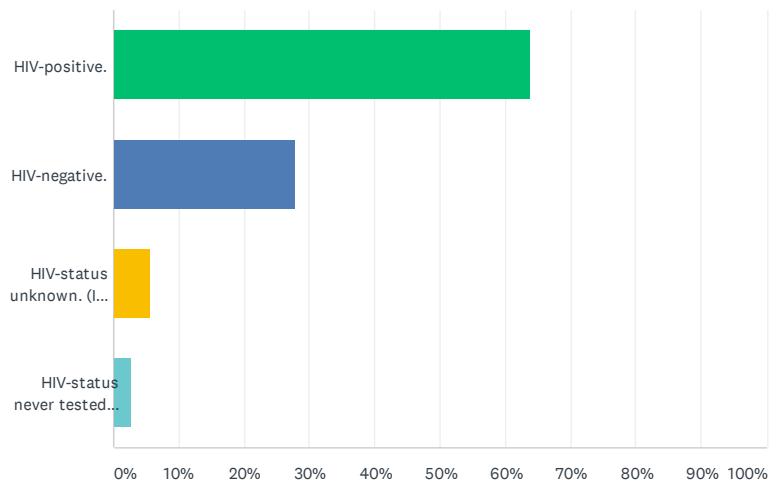

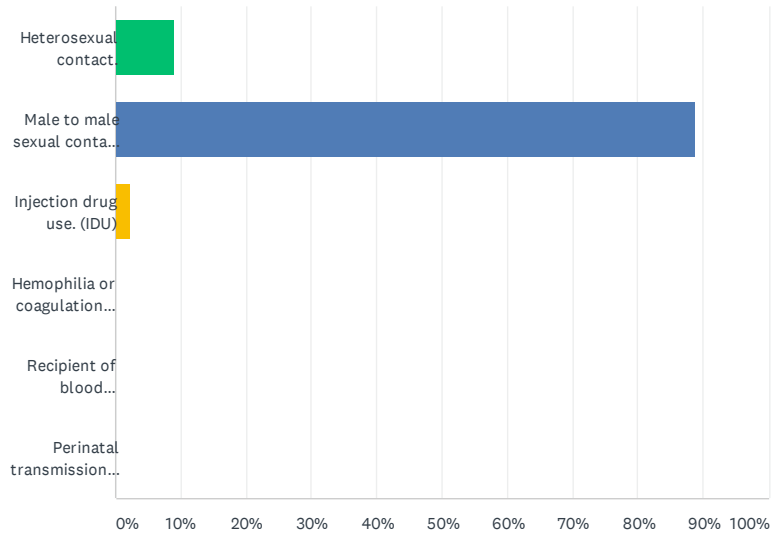

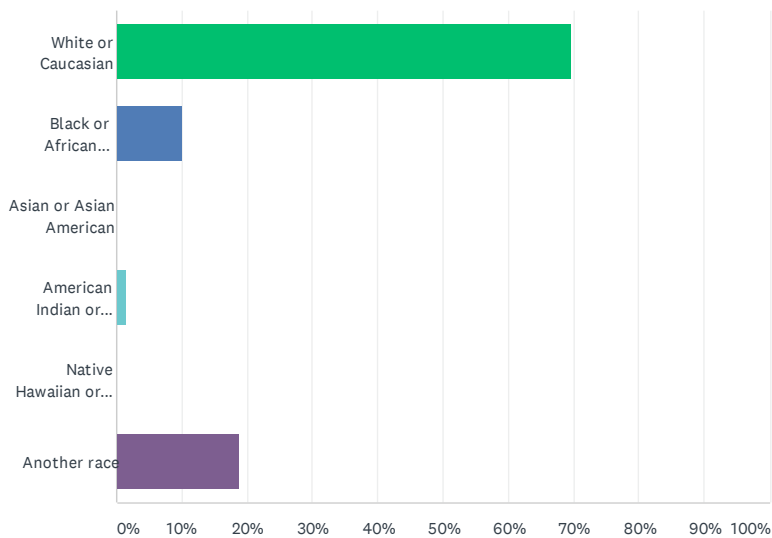

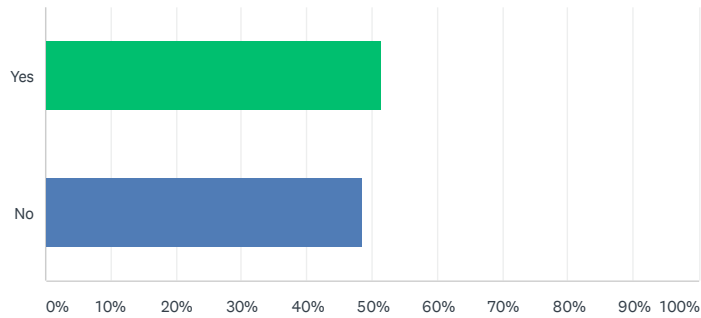

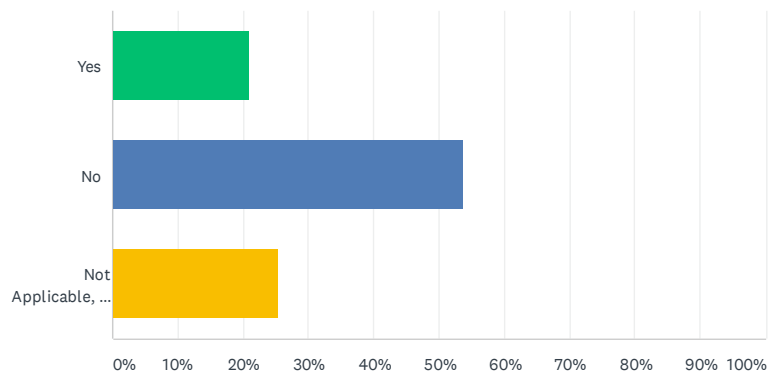

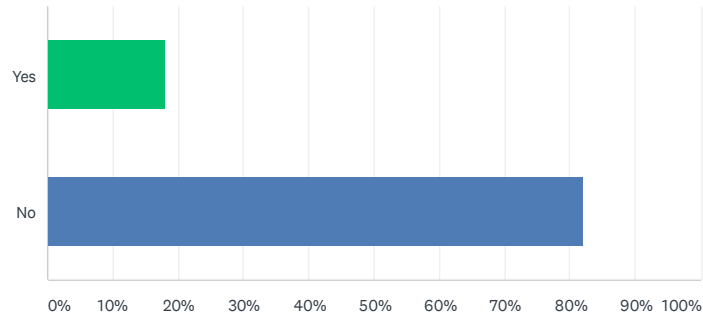

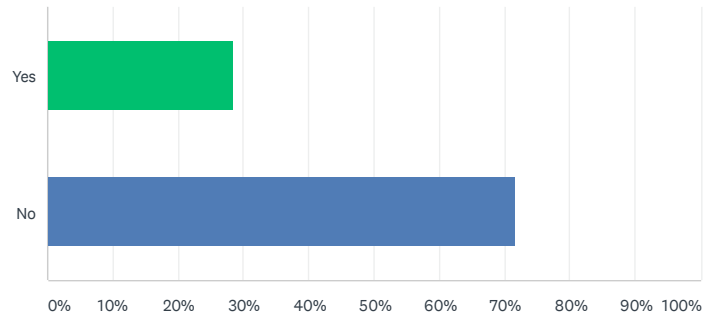

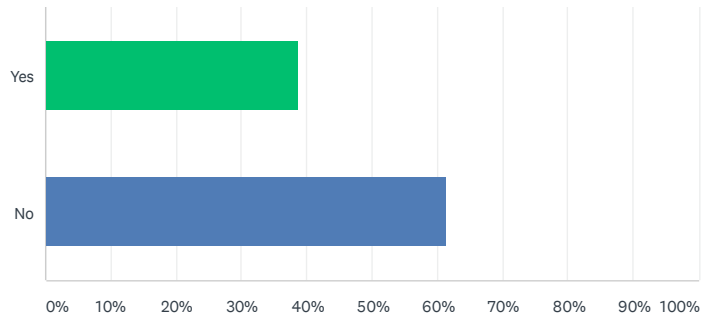

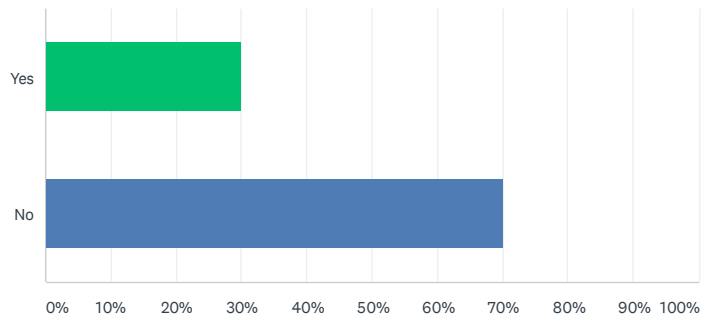

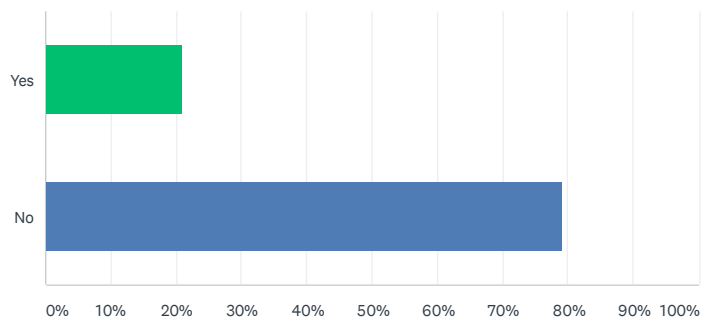

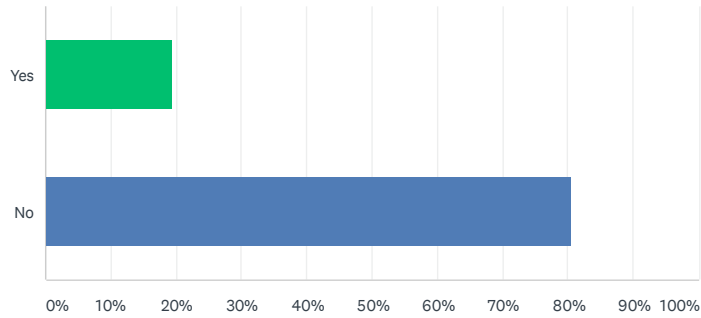

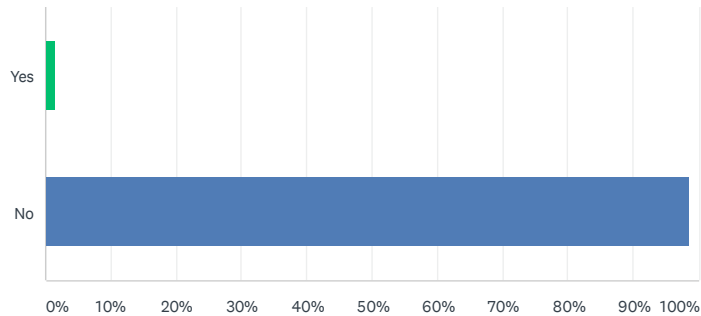

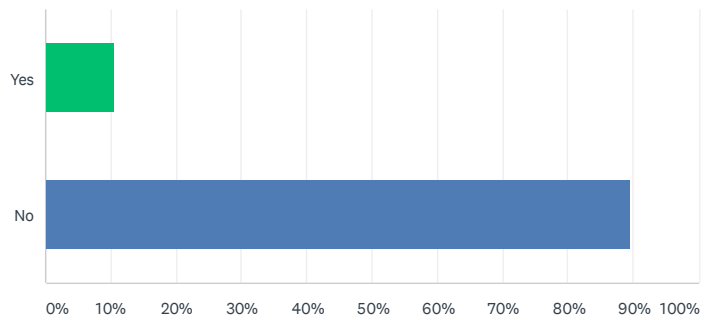

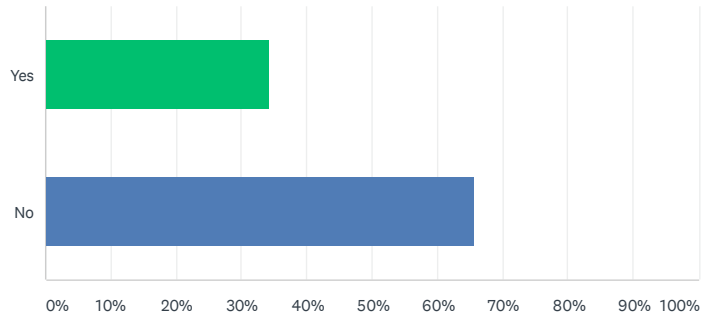

**Q21 Have you ever been physically forced to have sexual intercourse, when you did not want to?**

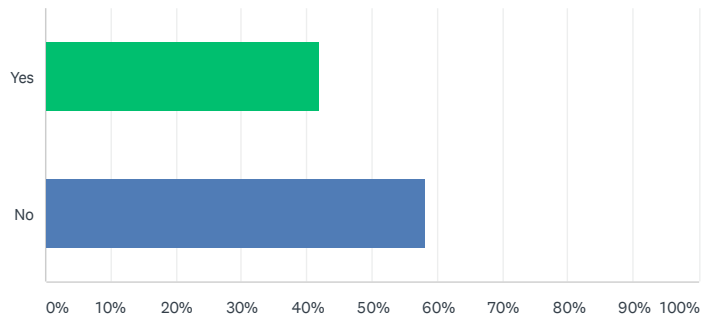

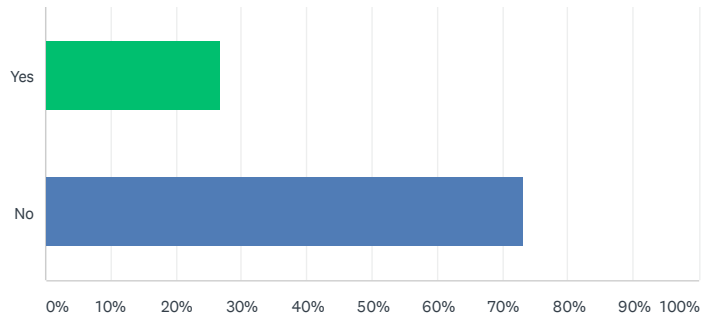

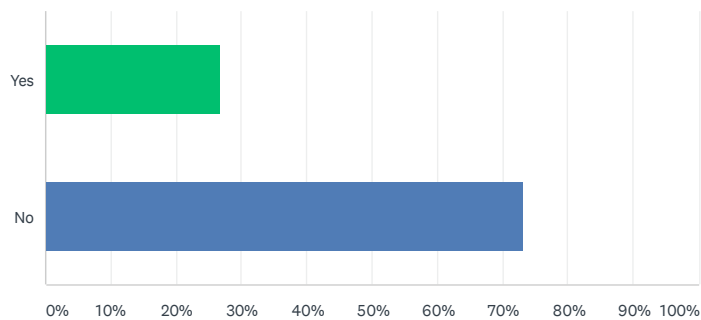

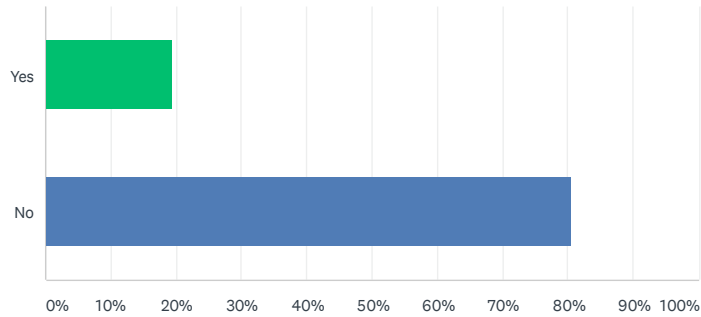

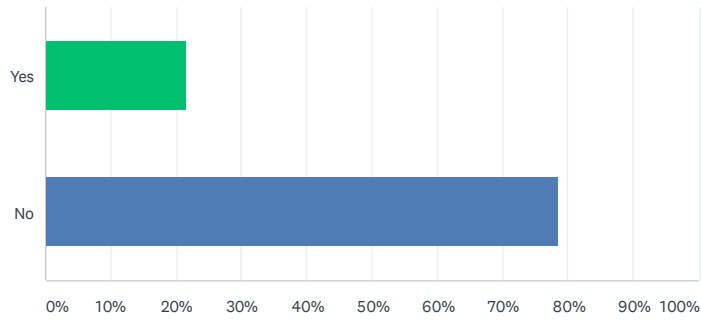

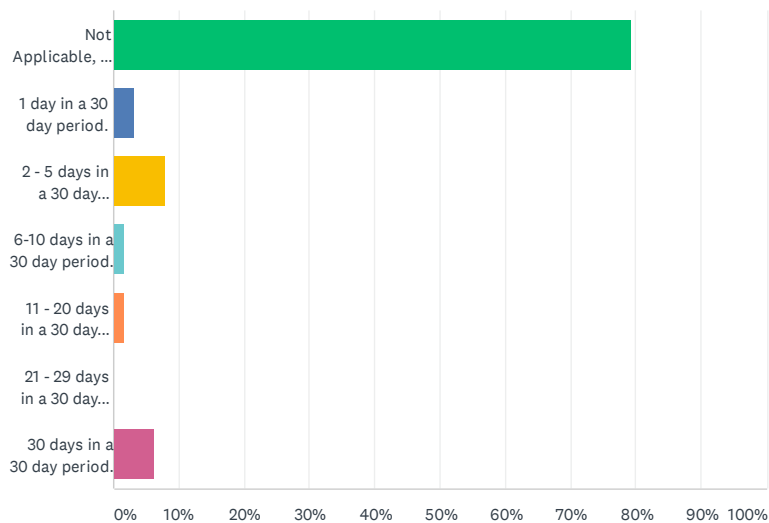

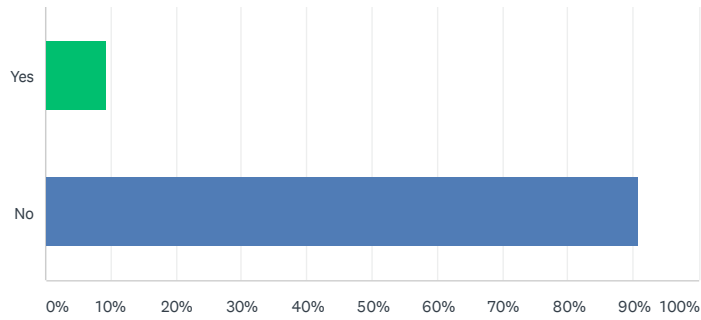

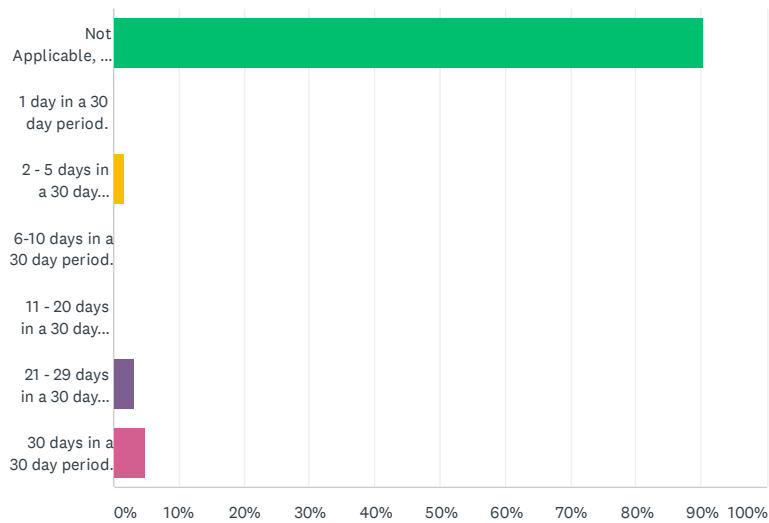

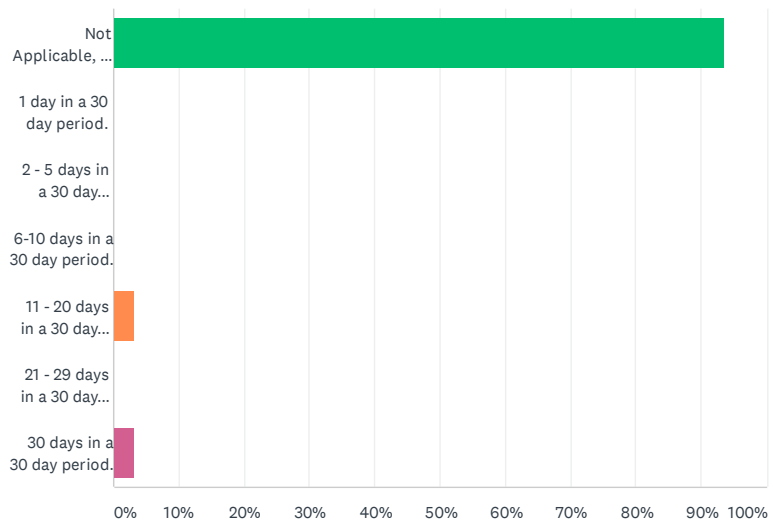

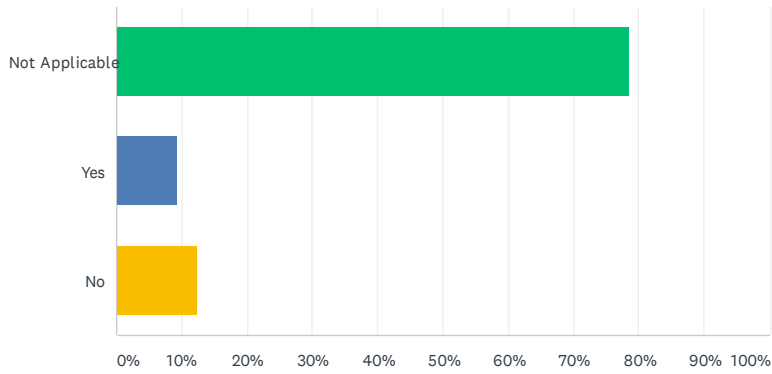

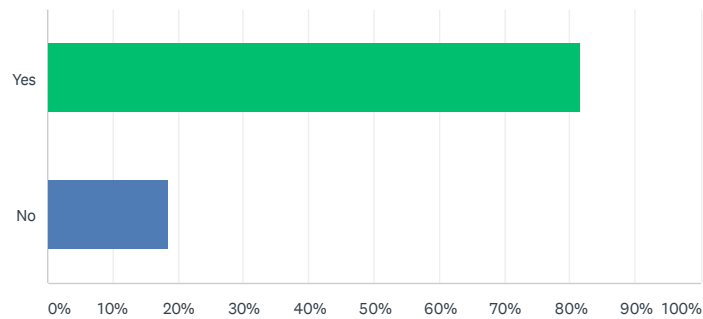

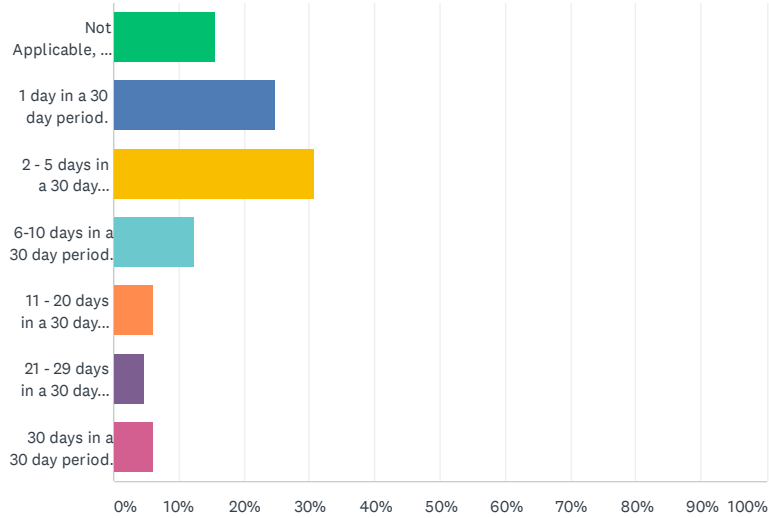

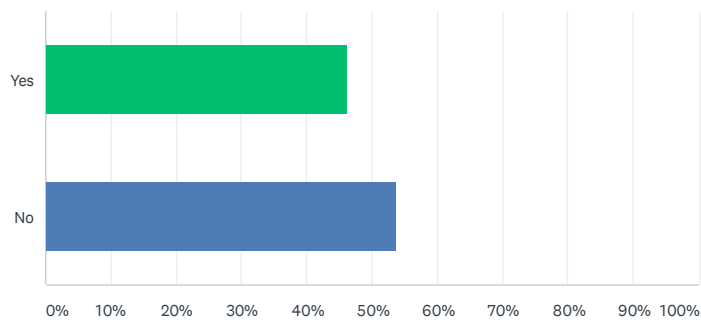

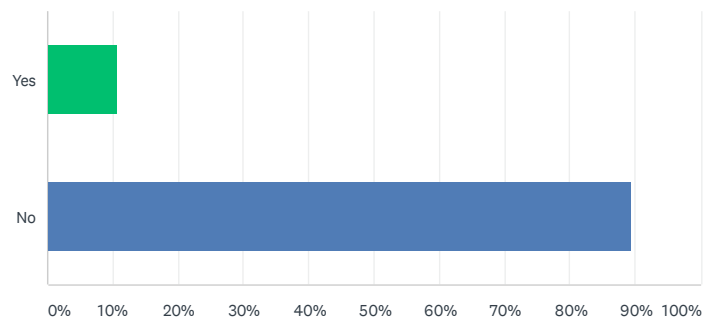

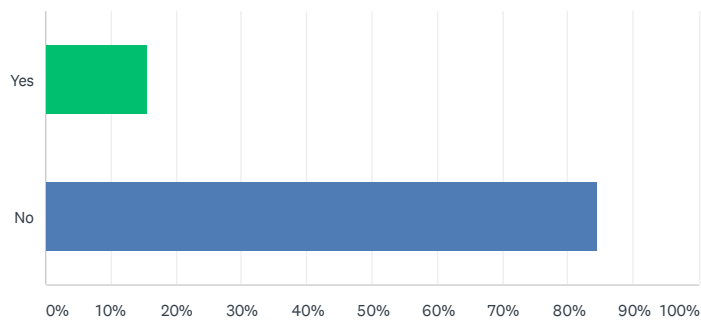

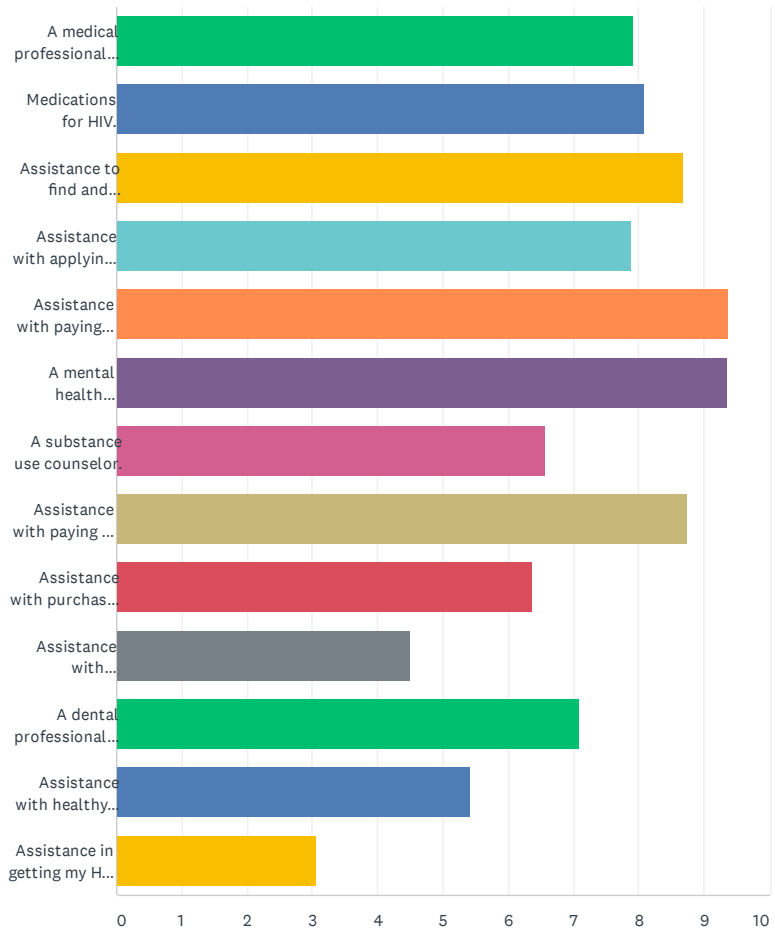

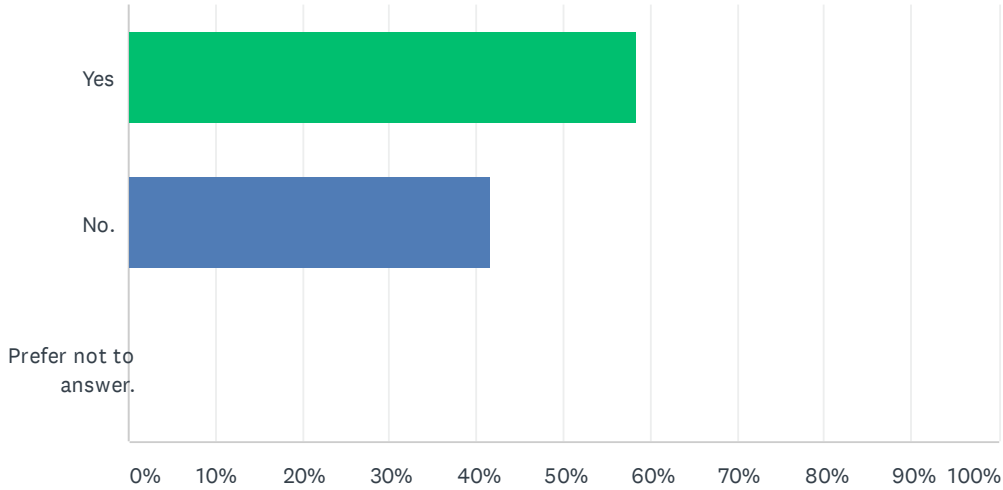

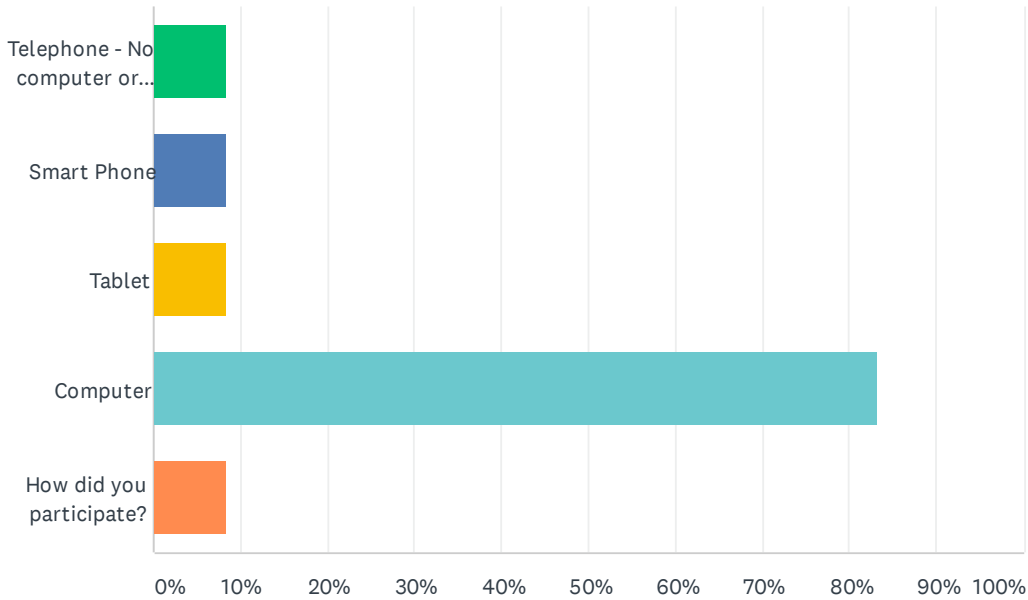

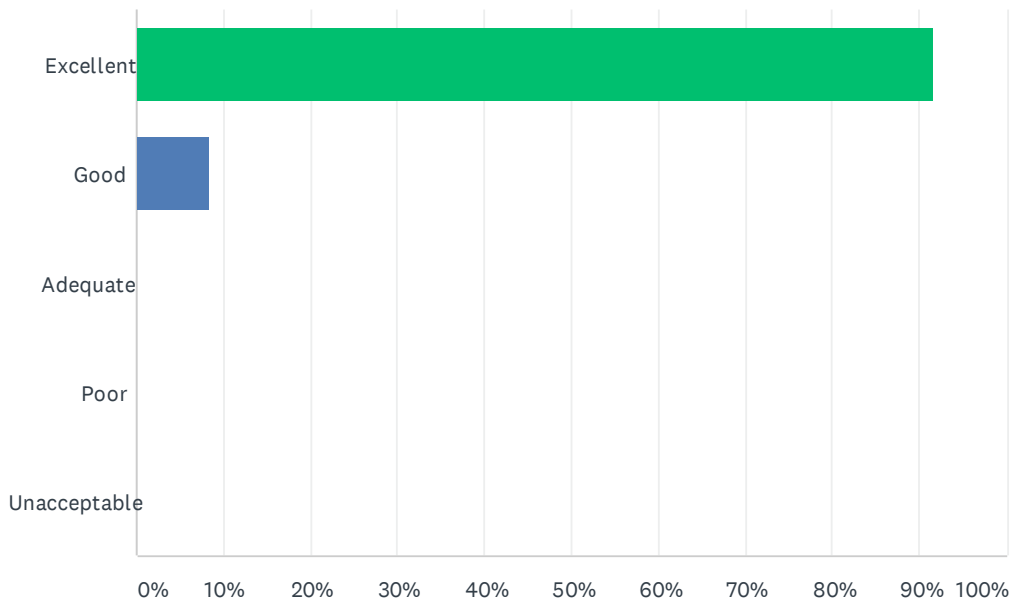

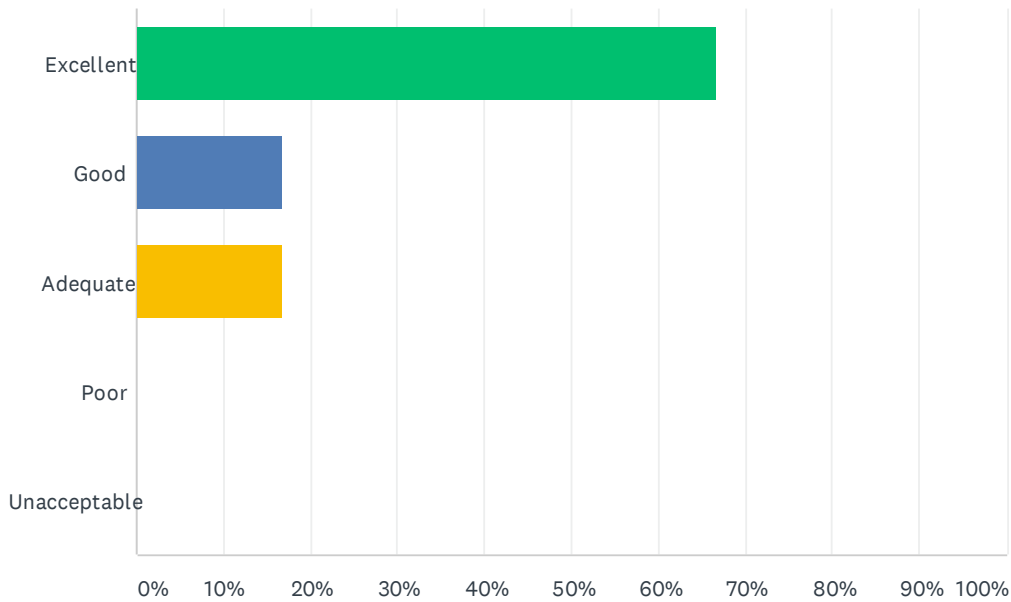

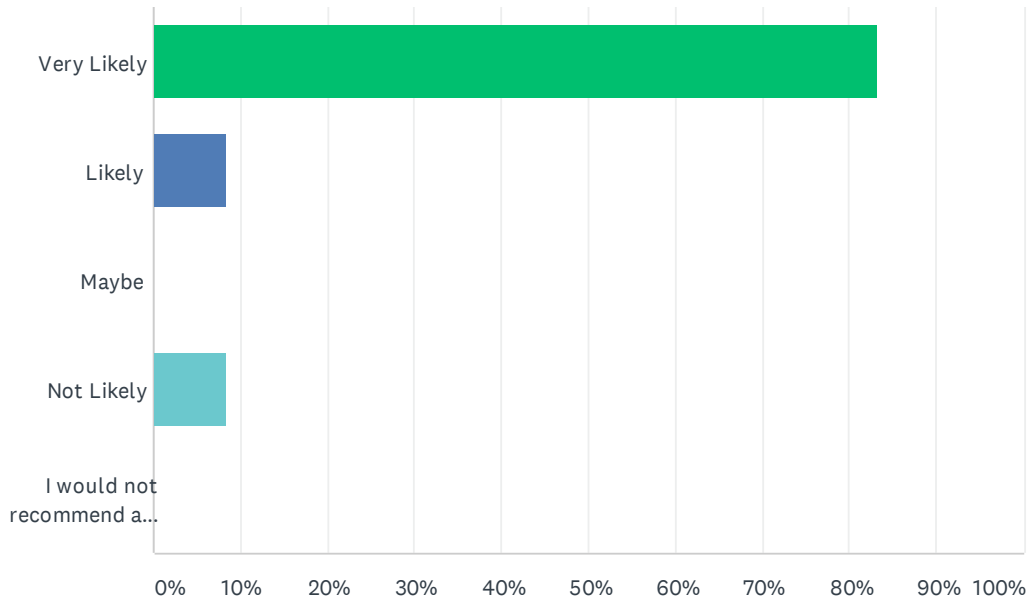

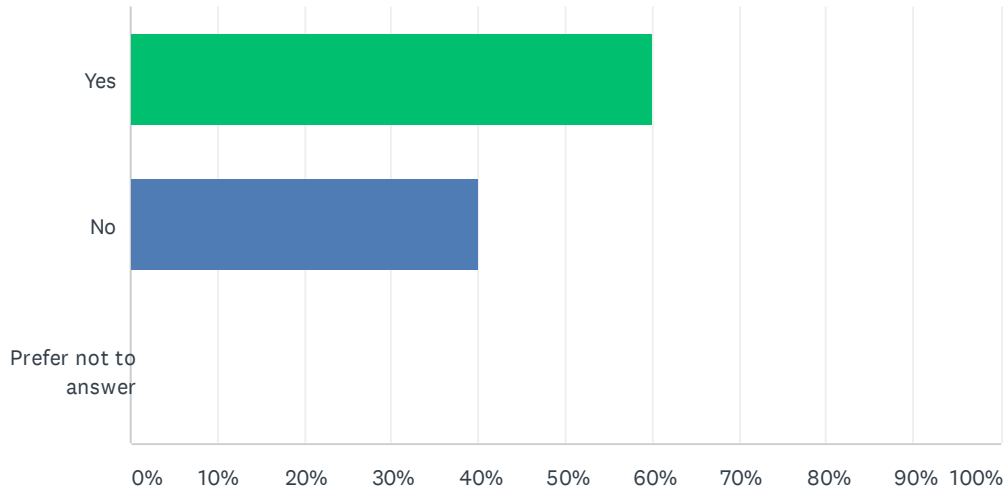

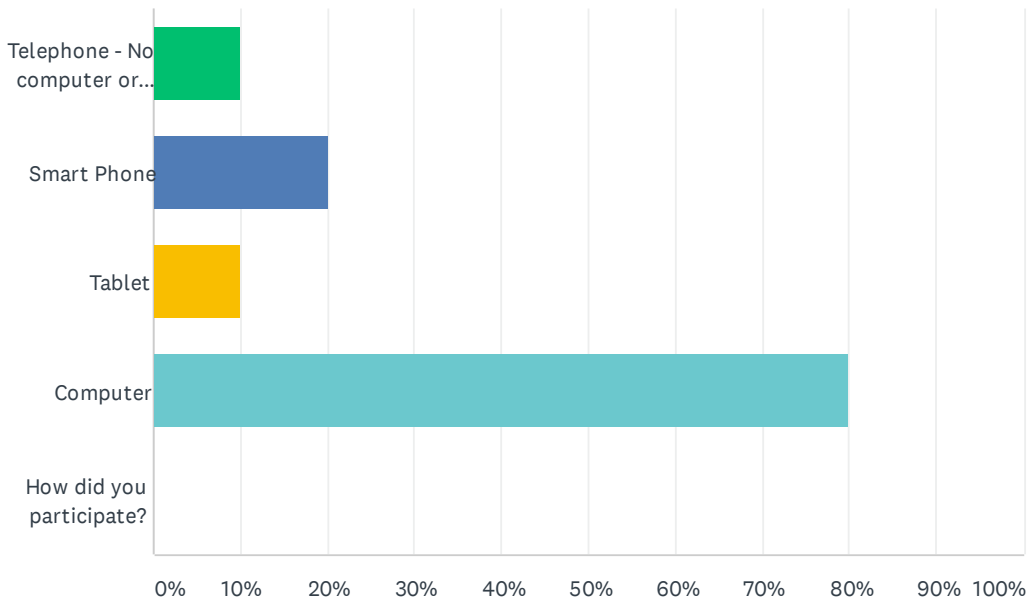

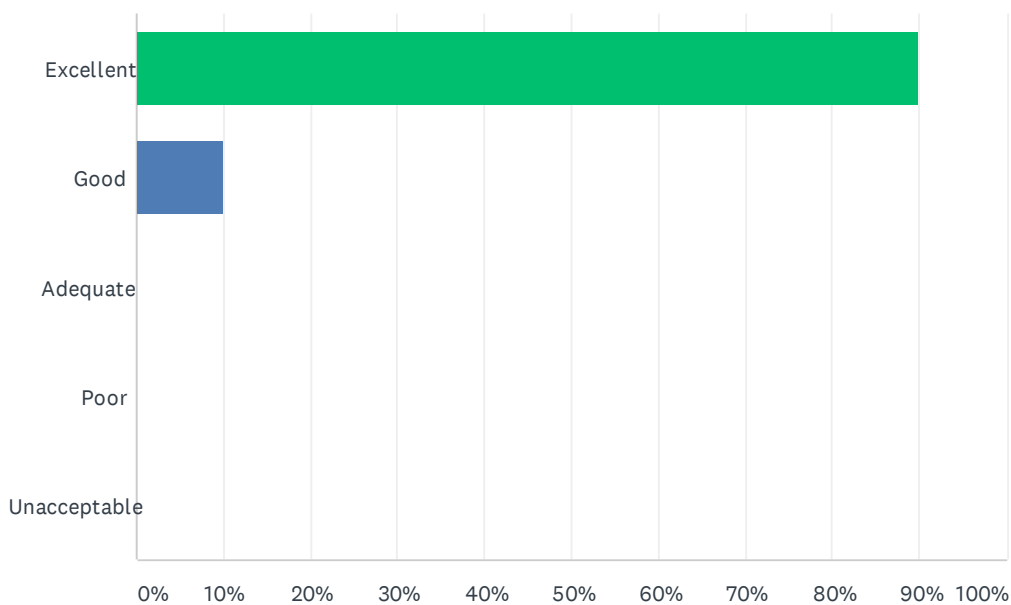

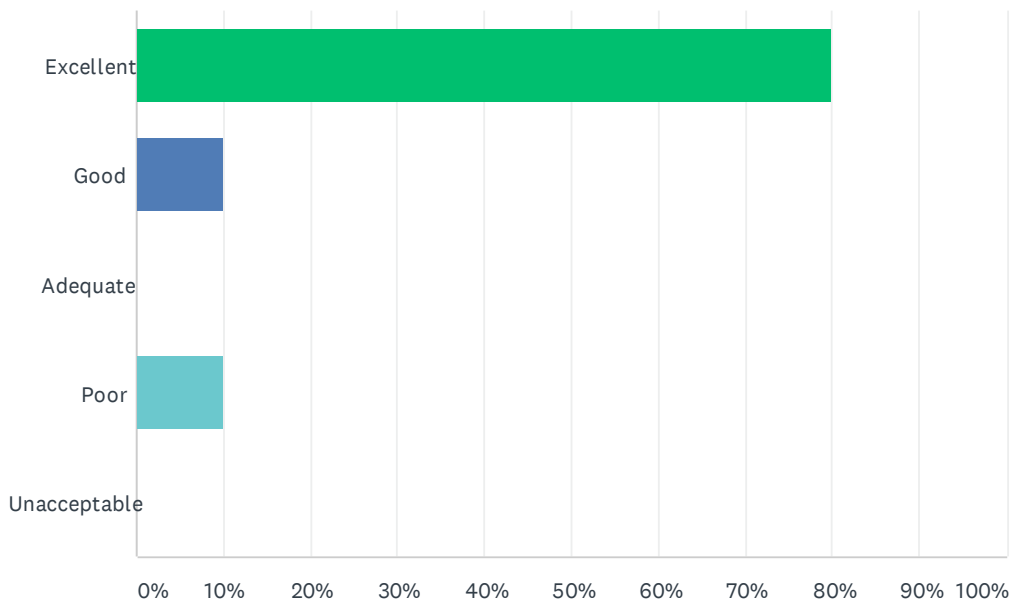

### Q6 Overall, how would you rate the data presented to set priorities and allocate resources to services categories for the 2021/2022 grant year?

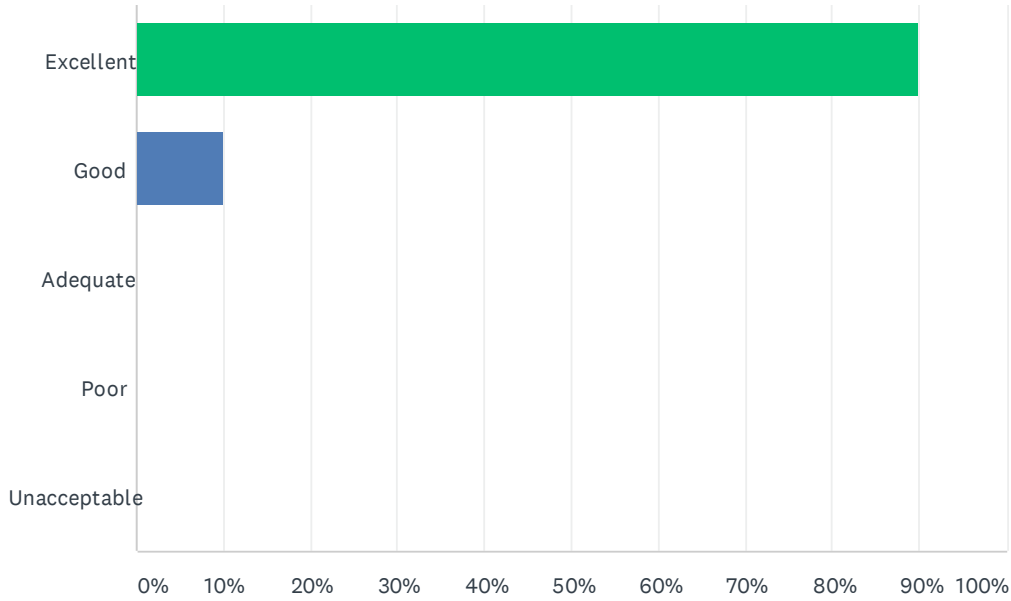

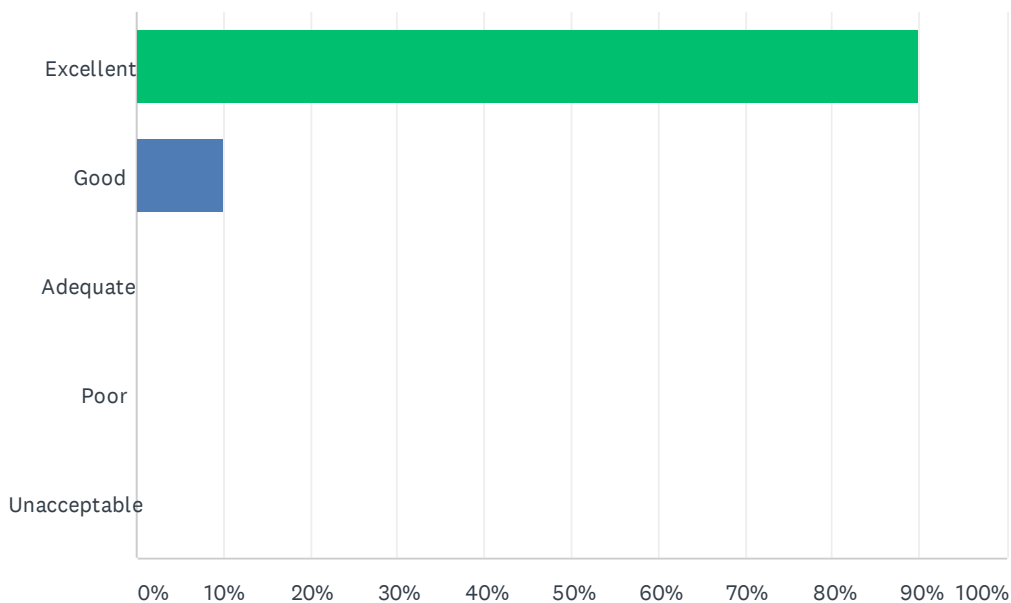
